1. 7 days before the procedure

- No aspirin, ibuprofen products, vitamin E, multi-vitamin, fish oil
- Tylenol products are allowed.
- Take all other medications as prescribed, unless instructed otherwise by the physician.
- Do not consume nuts, beans, seeds or corn.
- Discontinue Trulicity, Wegovy, Ozempic, Zepbound, Semaglutide, Saxenda, Tirzepatide and Rybelsus at least **7-8 days** before the procedure.

2. 1 day before the procedure

- The day before the procedure, you may not have any solid food from the time you wake up until you go to bed. Drink ONLY clear liquids all day (no red or purple).
- At **3pm**, take four (4) Dulcolax® laxative tablets (green box that's labeled "Gentle, Predictable Overnight Relief").
- At 4pm you will begin drinking the Miralax® laxative preparation:
 - In a pitcher, dissolve a 238-gram bottle of Miralax[®] in 64 ounces of Gatorade[®]. No red or purple flavors.
 - Mix well until the Miralax[®] is dissolved; do not add ice.
 - You may substitute Crystal Light[®] lemonade or iced tea for the Gatorade[®].
 - Between 4 and 6pm, drink one 8 ounce. glass of the mixture every 20-30 minutes, until halfway through the solution.
- Between 6pm and 7pm, you will break from drinking the solution for one hour.
- Between 7pm and 9pm, resume drinking one glass of mixture every 20-30 minutes until complete.



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Please do not eat or drink anything after midnight

3. Day of procedure

- Upon awakening, take your blood pressure medicine (if applicable) with a sip of water.
- No gum chewing or hard candy.
- Bring your **medication reconciliation** sheet or a list of your medication, including dosage, with you.
- Bring your insurance card and photo ID.
- All females under the age of 50 will be asked to provide a urine sample prior to the procedure.
- An adult must drive you home from your procedure. You are not allowed to use an Uber, Lyft or other ride-sharing service home from your procedure.
- You will be unable to drive or work for the remainder of the day after your procedure.

Due to our inability to fill surgical spots with short notice, cancellations within 48 hours of their scheduled time may be subject to a \$150 cancellation fee.

Not Clear Liquid
Red or purple items of any kind
Alcohol
Milk or Nondairy creamers
Noodles or vegetables in soup
Juice with pulp
Liquid you cannot see through

Tips:

- Eat light foods starting a few days before your procedure. This can make the prep easier.
- Drink your solution through a straw
- The more liquids you consume the better and easier the cleansing process.
