1. 7 days before the procedure

- No aspirin, ibuprofen products, vitamin E, multi-vitamin, fish oil
- Tylenol products are allowed.
- Take all other medications as prescribed, unless instructed otherwise by the physician.
- Do not consume nuts, beans, seeds or corn.
- Discontinue Trulicity, Wegovy, Ozempic, Zepbound, Semaglutide, Saxenda, Tirzepatide and Rybelsus at least **7-8 days** before the procedure.

2. 1 day before the procedure

- The day before the procedure, you may not have any solid food from the time you wake up until you go to bed. Drink ONLY clear liquids all day (no red or purple).
- At 2pm the day before your procedure:
 - Follow these instructions ONLY, not those on the SUTAB® box.
 - Fill the provided container with 16 ounces of water. Open one (1) bottle of tablets (12 tablets) and swallow each tablet with a sip of water.
 - drink the entire amount within 45 minutes, taking 1 tablet every 3-4 minutes.
 - Approximately 1 hour after you swallow the last tablet, fill the container again with 16 ounces of water and drink the entire amount within 30 minutes.
 - o Approximately 30 minutes later, drink another 16 ounces of water within 30 minutes.
- At **8pm** the day before your procedure:
 - Repeat all steps from 2pm
 - Drink an additional two (2) more 16-ounce containers of water over the next 1 hour.



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Please do not eat or drink anything after midnight

3. Day of procedure

- Upon awakening, take your blood pressure medicine (if applicable) with a sip of water.
- No gum chewing or hard candy.
- Bring your **medication reconciliation** sheet or a list of your medication, including dosage, with you.
- Bring your insurance card and photo ID.
- All females under the age of 50 will be asked to provide a urine sample prior to the procedure.
- An adult must drive you home from your procedure. You are not allowed to use an Uber, Lyft or other ride-sharing service home from your procedure.
- You will be unable to drive or work for the remainder of the day after your procedure.

Due to our inability to fill surgical spots with short notice, cancellations within 48 hours of their scheduled time may be subject to a \$150 cancellation fee.
